Lead researcher at the Legal Psychology and Protection of Minors research group at Universidad de A Coruña. President of the Commission of Legal Psychology at the Official Society of Psychologists (Colegio Oficial de Psicólogos) of Galicia, Spain.

RESEARCH

His research is focused mainly on Social Applied Psychology to social conflicts and Juridical Psychology. Among other things he has:

Developed an explanatory model for **female delinquency**.

Developed an explanatory approach to **social rehabilitation for prison inmates** (labeled rehabilitation vs. social risk), which has allowed creating a tool whose application is required to concede prison leaves to any inmate in a Spanish prison, the Risk Variables Table.

Maintained a research line on **violence, television and video games**.

Contributed with important theoretical developments to his fields of interest and is the **Head of a Master degree on social inclusion, gender and quality of life, social community services and equality policies**.

Research about de **defense of children** labelled by the PAS.

Briefly, his research contributions include:

Has authored **20 books**, 5 of them as the only author, and 15 other together with other authors. Of these 20 books, 10 are compilations and 10 are fully authored.

Over **30 articles in scientific journals**, some of them in journals of high international impact like "Journal of Social Psychology", "Aggressive Behavior", or "International Journal of Psychology".

Over **70 book chapters**, both in national and international publications.

Has supervised **7 Ph D. Thesis** and **5 Master Thesis**.

Has presented over **150 papers at conferences and scientific meetings**, totaling papers per se, symposia and posters.

Has lectured over **70 courses and seminars**.

Has been and is the **head of 5 Postgraduate and Master programs**. He is currently the head of the Master in Social Services Intervention and Management and the Master of Psychology Applied to Social and Juridical Environments, both at Universidad de A Coruña, Spain.

Has collaborated with international researchers during **3 research stajs** abroad.

Has **participated in over 20 research projects**, most of them as lead researcher.
